### ENLISTED EARLY TRANSITION PROGRAM QUOTA UPDATE

### BEES TO BADGES

The Bees to Badges program is a voluntary program for Seabees to apply for conversion to the MA rate prior to their CWAY window to balance the overmanned Seabee Community. The Seabee's security and small arms skill sets are in-line with the MA skill sets, providing for a smooth conversion to the MA rating. All Seabee ratings are eligible for conversion to the MA rating, with the exception of Seabees with NECs 5633, 5931, 5932, 5933, who are ineligible for this program.
