23 MAY 2003, AND EXTEND THROUGH MIDNIGHT, MONDAY, 26 MAY 2003. HISTORICALLY THIS IS ONE OF THE MOST DEADLY WEEKENDS ON OUR NATION'S HIGHWAYS. NAVY'S GOAL THIS MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND IS FOR ALL HANDS TO RETURN TO WORK ON TUESDAY, 27 MAY 2003 WITHOUT A SINGLE ALCOHOL RELATED INCIDENT. THIS GOAL IS ALIGNED WITH THE CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS (CNO) GOAL OF A 50 PERCENT REDUCTION IN ALCOHOL RELATED FATALITIES IN FY-03 AND THE CHIEF OF NAVAL PERSONNEL'S (CNP) MANDATE FOR A 25 PERCENT REDUCTION IN ALCOHOL RELATED INCIDENTS.

2. THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION (NHTSA) REPORTS ALCOHOL-RELATED TRAFFIC DEATHS HAVE INCREASED FOR THE THIRD YEAR IN A ROW. AS OUR SAILORS AND THEIR FAMILIES PREPARE TO TRAVEL, RELAX AT LAKES, BEACHES AND PARTIES THIS MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND IT IS LEADERSHIP'S RESPONSIBILITY TO REMIND ALL HANDS THAT ALCOHOL IMPAIRS JUDGMENT AND SLOWS REACTION TIME WHETHER YOU ARE DRIVING ON THE ROADWAYS OR THE WATERWAYS. DRUNK DRIVING IS NOT AN ACCIDENT, IT IS A CHOICE AND 100 PERCENT PREVENTABLE. CNO AND CNP WANT EVERYONE TO MAKE THE RIGHT CHOICE: IF YOU CHOOSE TO DRINK, BE RESPONSIBLE, DO NOT DRINK AND DRIVE. LET'S HAVE AN ENJOYABLE AND SUCCESSFUL MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND BY HAVING ALL HANDS AT WORK ON TUESDAY, 27 MAY 2003.
