1. NAVADMIN 031/95 CNO WASHINGTON DC 092030Z FEB 95

Subj: ENLISTED ADMINISTRATIVE SEPARATION PROCESSING INITIATIVES

Effective 9 February 1995 all personnel diagnosed as alcohol dependent must be offered treatment via Military Treatment Facility prior to separation. The only exception are members who have received Level III equivalent treatment (whether successfully completed or not) within past three (3) years are not eligible for treatment.

Subj: DON ALCOHOL ABUSE PREVENTION AND DEGLAMORIZATION CAMPAIGN

SECNAV announces Navy and USMC to establish a comprehensive Alcohol Abuse Prevention and Deglamorization Campaign. Established 1 April 96 as effective date all DON Bases/Installations will strictly conform to drinking age limitations of the State or Country in which they are located.

Effective 1 March 92 mandatory processing for separation of all personnel E1 and above guilty of a single incident of drug abuse.

Revised technical requirements for Urinalysis collection: 30 ML vice 60ML as minimum sample level; new custody document; new premise codes.

Subj: DD 2624 URINALYSIS CHAIN OF CUSTODY FORM

Effective 1 October 1995 all Navy commands shall use the DoD Specimen Custody Document DD 2624 as a replacement to OPNAV 5350/2.

14. NAVADMIN 108/96 CNO WASHINGTON DC 021316Z MAY 96

Subj: VOLUNTARY SELF-REFERRAL FOR DRUG ABUSE REHABILITATION

Effective 2 May 1996 personnel who self refer for drug abuse and are screened as "drug dependent" and conform to other requirements outlined in OPNAV 5350.4b shall be exempt from disciplinary action, offered treatment and processed for separation. Personnel screened "not drug dependent" will not be exempt from disciplinary action.

15. PERS 6 MEMO FOR DISTRIBUTION 5350 SER 603C/00792 dtd 13Jun96

Subj: ADMINISTRATIVE SEPARATION FOR INHALANT ABUSE

Provides detailed guidance regarding processing for administrative separation personnel who abuse inhalants.

16. PERS-6 MEMO FOR DISTRIBUTION 5350 SER 603/00283 dtd 7APR97

Subj: POLICY DECISION MEMORANDUM: DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE
SEMIANNUAL REPORT (DAASAR)

Effective immediately, submission of DAASAR, enclosure (12) of OPNAV 5350.4b is no longer required.

17. DRUG ABUSE ADVISORY 2-98 COMNAVPERSCOM 171000Z DEC 98

Subj: URINALYSIS PROGRAM

Effective immediately COs are authorized to increase monthly urinalysis to 40 percent of personnel assigned and conduct 5 Unit Sweeps annually. Current policy of 10 percent monthly minimum remains.

18. DRUG ABUSE ADVISORY 1-99 COMNAVPERSCOM 181000Z FEB 99

Subj: URINALYSIS PROGRAM

Effective immediately IAW new U.S. Postal Regs, all packages containing urinalysis specimens mailed to Navy Drug Screening Labs must be clearly marked "Clinical Specimens - Urine Samples" on the address side of the package.

19. CNPC MEMO FOR DISTRIBUTION 5350 SER 603/00031 dtd 16 Feb99

Subj: ADMINISTRATIVE SEPARATION FOR ABSINTHE USE

Provides commands with information on how to prevent Sailors from using Absinthe and other products that contain substances banned by the Food and Drug Administration.
